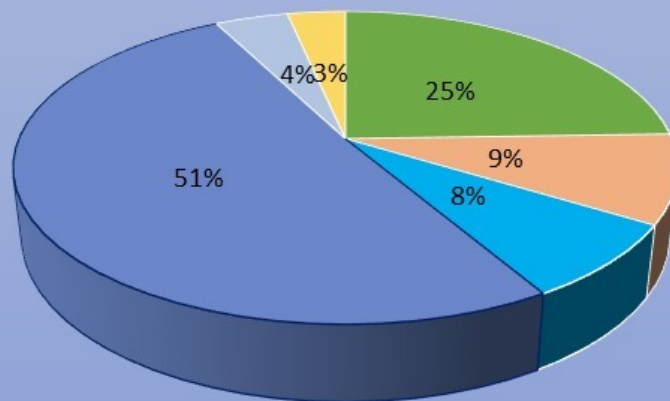
Vision:

1. EDUCATION

Meritorious Girls Scholarship:

TWEET is dedicated to empowering exceptional young women hailing from economically disadvantaged backgrounds through its Meritorious Girls Scholarship Programs. This scholarship serves as a vital lifeline, enabling these talented girls to pursue their higher education at a variety of esteemed educational institutions, fostering their dreams and ambitions.

Till date TWEET has supported 38 students under the meritorious scholarship scheme and six of them have joined in foreign universities for their higher education.

Adult Literacy Program:

TWEET's Adult Literacy Program is designed to empower women within the community by equipping them with essential reading and writing skills. This initiative not only fosters self-confidence but also opens up new avenues for employment, enabling women to take charge of their futures and achieve independence.



TWEET had Adult Literacy Centres at Shram Vihar, Jahangirpuri, Kanchan Kunj, Jamia Nagar and Madanpur Khader in Delhi; Jabalpur in Madhya Pradesh; and Bhilai and Raipur in Chhattisgarh. The organisation conducted a one-year long campaign Freedom From Illiteracy (FFI), with the slogan of Each One Teach Ten from Aug 2022 to July 2023. The major mission of the campaign was to engage educated women all over the country to volunteer for educating at least 10 non-literate adult women.

2. ECONOMIC EMPOWERMENT

- a. Livelihood support: TWEET's Livelihood Support Program is making a profound impact on the lives of destitute women grappling with financial difficulties. Through targeted training and access to resources for income-generating activities, this program empowers women to embrace a life of independence and dignity, helping them to regain control over their circumstances and achieve lasting respect within their communities.

TWEET supported three women to start boutiques, two women to start cloth shops, two women to start detergent units, one for tiffin service and another one for starting a cosmetic shop. And five women were supported with sewing machines to start stitching from their home itself.

- b. Entrepreneurship development: The entrepreneurship development program is designed to equip aspiring female entrepreneurs with the skills, knowledge, and resources needed to start and grow their business. TWEET supported different women groups for entrepreneurship development like starting an agarbatti manufacturing unit, jute bag production unit, and women friendly marketplace.

- c. **Skill development:** TWEET runs Skill Development Centres aiming at providing employment-oriented skills to women. TWEET has tailoring and stitching centres at Shram Vihar and Jahangirpuri in Delhi and Ranchi in Jharkhand.

3. WIDOW SUPPORT:

TWEET's Widow Support Program offers a compassionate lifeline to women who have lost their spouses, helping them to navigate the emotional and financial challenges they face. The program provides essential financial aid, along with individual and group counselling services, ensuring these women receive both the emotional support and practical resources needed to rebuild their lives with strength and resilience.

a. Financial support:

Under this scheme TWEET provides a monthly pension to the widows who do not have a social structure to rely on. This not only helps them to manage their necessities but also reduces the chance of their exploitation. Till date we have supported 28 widows by giving monthly pensions.



b. Individual and group counselling services:

Through individual counselling sessions, the team has maintained regular contact with widows and motivated them to regain their courage and think positively about their lives and their children's future.

Group counselling sessions were designed to enhance their self-confidence, provide guidance on nurturing their children and encourage them to lead a dignified life through proper education.

TWEET conducted group counselling sessions at Delhi, Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, Punjab, Haryana, Rajasthan, Assam, West Bengal and Madhya Pradesh.

4. SOCIAL EMPOWERMENT:

TWEET's social empowerment is about fostering the ability of individuals and communities to shape their own destinies and participate fully in society. By promoting equal opportunities, access to resources, and a supportive environment, social empowerment helps marginalized groups, especially women and the economically disadvantaged, to gain the confidence and skills necessary to improve their quality of life and contribute meaningfully to societal development.

6. FELICITATION PROGRAM:

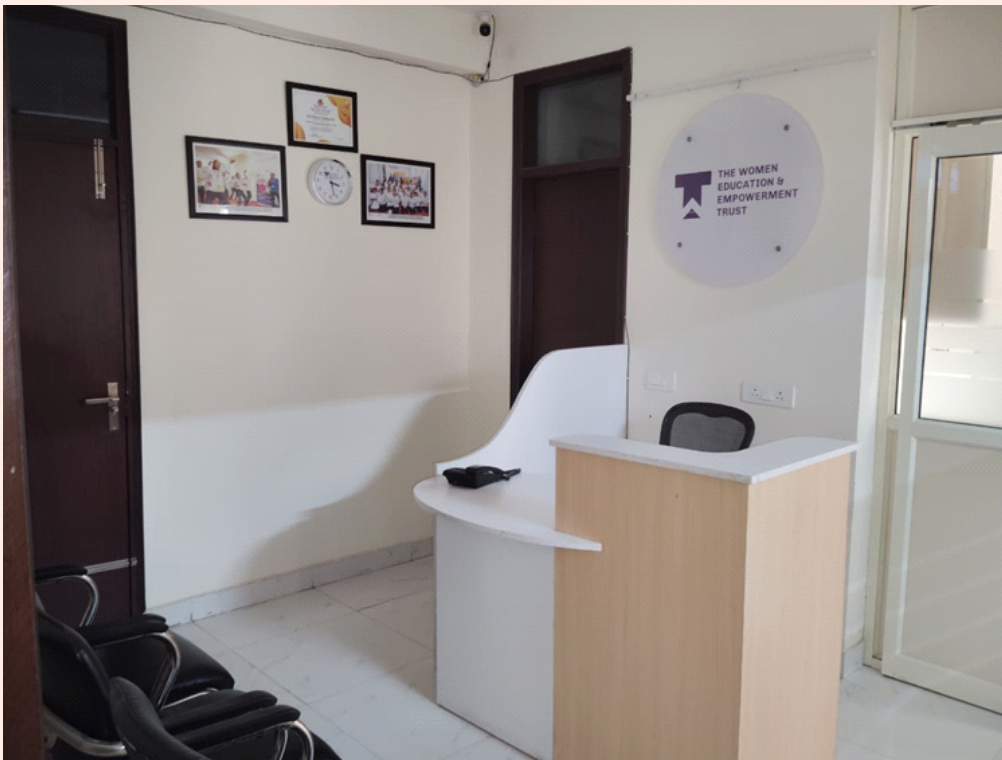

The Women Facilitation Centre serves as a haven for women, offering a secure environment where they can access vital services, support, and guidance. With the aim of empowerment, the center provides an array of resources, including counselling and guidance services, legal assistance, welfare scheme assistance and capacity building programs. By cultivating a nurturing atmosphere, the center enables women to foster self-reliance and bolster their confidence.



8. ACCOMMODATION FACILITIES FOR GIRLS:

The accommodation facilities for girls at the Women Education and Empowerment Trust offers a safe and comfortable living environment for women pursuing education or job. With essential amenities and supportive atmosphere, the hostel allows women to concentrate on their studies and professional development. It serves as a crucial stepping stone for women aiming to achieve independence and seize better opportunities for their future. The hostel is running with a total capacity of 27.

9. MAHILA HELP DESK:

The Mahila Help Desk is a specialized service offering immediate support to women confronting issues such as domestic violence, legal challenges, or financial hardship. Manned by trained professionals, it provides essential guidance, links women to vital resources, and ensures their concerns are addressed. As a crucial lifeline in times of crisis, the help desk plays a pivotal role in safeguarding the well-being and security of women in need. Till date, 100 needy women benefited through this project.
