> Financial Literacy Program

TWEET's economic empowerment program includes a comprehensive financial literacy program designed to equip women with the knowledge and skills necessary to manage their finances effectively. The program aims to promote financial inclusion, independence, and stability among women.

TWEET conducted a webinar on financial literacy 'Start your journey of financial wellbeing-unlock the skills to manage, invest, and grow' on 24 Dec 2024 via zoom meet. Financial expert, Mr. Usama Khan led the session. One hundred eight volunteers across India participated in the program and grass root level financial literacy programs are implementing through them.





MAHILA HELP DESK

The Mahila Help Desk serves as a pivotal resource, providing comprehensive information on various government schemes, facilitating applications, elucidating the intricacies of the justice delivery system, and aiding in the registration of complaints for victims of crimes against women. TWEET conducted Mahila Help Desk camps at Kanchan Kunj, Dashrath Puri, Jhangirpuri, Batla House and Majdoor Kalyan Camp in Delhi; and Shadarpur, Noida in UP.

The Women Facilitation Centre, which includes a hostel, operates seamlessly with the capacity of 27. The objective of this program is to support women and girls who are coming to Delhi for job and education purpose by giving safe accommodation facilities. The organization offers essential amenities such as meals, WIFI connectivity, access to a study room, cleaning services, breakfast, and dinner with basic accommodation facilities. Furthermore, we organize monthly programs aimed at fostering the personal and professional growth of the residents. 226 women benefitted from this program in this time period.

> Meet The Scholar

Meet the scholar is the monthly program conduct at the TWEET girls' hostel. The program is to connect the students with accomplished individuals in their field of study, allowing students to gain insights into potential career paths, learn about research opportunities and receive guidance on academic pursuits by engaging in direct interaction with a recognized expert essentially providing a platform for mentorship and inspiration through personal interaction with a successful scholar.





RELIEF & REHABILITATION

The relief activities like provision for food, cloth, shelter, medical support, marriage assistance for poor girls is also done in TWEET, this initiative extends the organization's outreach to the most marginalized individuals, who are often overlooked and in need of basic needs.
